

ROGUE ELKS RV'ERS

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be a paid-up member or widow of any Elks Lodge.
2. Pay the annual dues each April of \$12.00 per RV. If you join after April the amount is prorated at \$1.00 per month.
3. Enjoy camping and having fun.

EXPECTATIONS:

1. Attend monthly meetings on the first Wednesday of each month, at 7 pm, at the Lodge or as planned.
2. Attend at least two camp outs during the year to remain active. Those not attending the trips will be contacted to determine whether they wish to remain active in the group.
3. Take your turn as Wagonmaster or co host.
4. Support other functions the R.V. Club may volunteer for in support of the Lodge.
5. Have fun.

PRESIDENT DUTIES:

1. Conduct all meetings
2. Find place and time for each meeting.
3. Call for reports from each committee.
4. Appoint a Sheriff to collect fines at the meetings.

WAGONMASTER GUIDELINES FOR A RALLY:

1. Pick a site for a camp out. Try to keep within 150 miles of Medford.
2. Make necessary arrangements in advance.
3. Give directions to the camp site and information on any activities planned.

OPTIONAL GUIDELINES FOR WAGONMASTER:

1. Pass a sign up sheet if needed.
2. Prepare coffee (pot & coffee provided)
3. Appoint a sheriff and deputy (kept secret from others).
4. Appoint someone to write a rally report for the historian and the Elk's Bulletin.(Put in Mac's box by the 15th of the month)

SECRETARY/TREASURER DUTIES:

1. Take minutes at meetings.
2. Writes newsletter and forwards to all members.
3. Collects all monies, I.e. dues, fines and etc. Makes deposits of same.
4. Write any checks for ordering badges, campground deposits, postage and any miscellaneous bills that are due.

MISCELLANEOUS FACTS:

1. Dues may be changed by a majority vote of the members.
2. The Club year is from April through March.

3. The officers consist of a President, Secretary-treasurer, and Trail Boss elected at the March 2010 meeting. The Wagonmaster will be the person in charge of the outing they are hosting.
4. Volunteer jobs: Historian and Sunshine.
5. Keep the sunshine chairman advised of any illness, etc.
6. Members may bring guests to two (2) camp outs. Requested to notify the President.
7. Guests are always welcome at the monthly meetings.
8. Camp outs are usually held the third week end of the month. However, the President names the date.
9. The main object is having fun.
10. Printing and mailing may be reimbursed.
11. Historian: takes pictures of rallies and places them in books. Brings photo books to the meetings. If the historian is unable to attend a rally he/she should ask someone else to do the job. Expenses are paid by the group.
